

FRONT

- 1. Raise ATV off ground, secure on jack stands, and remove Wheels.
- 2. Remove bolt securing top of Shock to Frame.
- Install Flat Bracket (A) to inside of factory mount, toward front. Install Bolt (E), Washer (F), and Spacer (H). See Fig. 1.
- Install Formed Bracket, Right (B) on outside of factory mount, towards rear. Secure with Washer (F) and Nut (G). See Fig. 1 and Fig. 1a.
- 5. Reinstall Shock into new Bracket. Secure with factory hardware.
- 6. Repeat for opposite side.
- 7. Reinstall Wheels and ensure that hardware is tightened completely.

REAR

- 1. Raise ATV off ground, secure on jack stands, and remove Wheels.
- Use a Spring Compressor, or 2 to 3 Ratchet Straps, and compress Spring at top of Shock. Compress just enough to allow Spring Spacer (D) in. See Fig. 2.
- 3. Remove bolt securing bottom of Shock.
- 3. Remove and discard Plate from bottom of Spring and insert machined end of Spring Spacer (D). See Fig. 2 and Fig. 3.
- Slowly decompress Spring to secure Spring Spacer (D) and reinstall bottom bolt to secure Shock. See Fig. 3.
- 5. Repeat for opposite side.
- 6. Reinstall Wheels and ensure that hardware is tightened completely.
